Through this hands-on project, the students not only improved their understanding of the utilisation of renewable energy and honed their technical knowledge, but also provided the village with a useable, cost-effective and sustainable solution.



The Pandemonium Jamming Space is a hotspot for students to kick back and jam up some funky sounds and music.




